# Academic 0.01 - User Guide - AV Equipment



The AV system is controlled using the touch panel. When not in use the screen goes to sleep. Press the touch panel's screen to start or wake-up the touch panel.

### Source Selection

This is done with the touch panel.

Choose what is displayed on-screen and heard from the speakers by pressing a source button.



Your chosen source button will be highlighted.

### **DISPLAY**

There are 3 displays, the Main display and also two "Repeater" screens towards the back.



Switch a display on by pressing its touch panel button. Please switch off after use.



## PC

The PC is located in the lectern and must be switched on manually. Also switch on the monitor.

Press



to display the PC. The selected choice will be highlighted.

**USB** devices can be connected using the socket on the lectern panel.



#### **LAPTOPS**

The connection plate on the lectern includes an HDMI connection for laptops and other devices that have HDMI output built-in or via an adaptor.

**Press** 



to select the HDMI input.



#### **AUDIO DEVICES**

Use the Stereo Audio input for connecting MP3 / iPod players etc.

**Press** 



to choose this source to hear through the speakers.

NB: the projector does not need to be switched on if just using audio.

NB: raise the volume on your device before raising the volume on touch panel.



## **CAMERA & LECTURE RECORDING**

There is a fixed camera on the ceiling for the purpose of lecture recording. The camera feed is shown in the *Panopto* software (aka *ChiPlayer*) which is available on the computer. The microphones described below feed into *Panopto*.

When using *Panopto*, press the touch panel's **Camera Control** button to alter the camera position etc.




## MICROPHONES

Press the mic mute button to mute the microphones.

The Mic Controls button on the touch panel is for technician use only.

There is a lectern mic, and also a wireless Revolab mic which is available for loan from the SIZ desk (remember to return the Revolab mic after use).



To switch Revolab mic OFF - either hold the mic button until the light stays red and then release button (light goes out); OR return the mic to its charger base.

To switch Revolab mic ON - the mic automatically turns on and mutes when removed from its charger base. Place mic around neck and un-mute it by pressing and releasing the mic button - the light will flash green to show it is On.



## DVD / BluRay

The lectern contains a DVD/BluRay player which is controlled from the touch panel. The DVD player can play DVDs or BluRay discs.



to display the DVD. Press DVD Control to access the DVD controls.



## **VOLUME & OTHER CONTROLS**

Use the sound.



Home - takes you back to the touch panel main screen.



Display blank - blanks the big screen display to the audience



Switch off the lecture system including displays
