



## **Arundel and District Community Hospital**

We specialize in patient rehabilitation. Typically, patients are admitted following either emergency or elective orthopaedic surgery or may come after an acute admission following a severe infection. Most of our patients are over 65 years of age.

Medical cover is provided by the Arundel Practice of GP's. There is a medical round every weekday. Tuesdays, the consultant attends the Multidisciplinary Ward meeting with members of the Allied Health Professionals, Nursing and Social Care Professionals.

## **Working Patterns**

Early: 7:30 -15:30 = 7.5 hours Late: 13:00 - 21:00 = 7.5 hours Night: 21:00 - 07:45 = 10.45 hours

You are expected to work a variety of shifts to gain 24-hour care experience, including weekends. You will be required to always wear your student uniform with ID badge. A 'bare below the elbow' is strictly enforced – so no nail varnish or jewellery apart from a plain wedding band
