The department is run by a resident doctor and Emergency nurse practitioners as well as staff nurses and is open to the public 7 days a week between 09:00-17:00. We see any age who has sustained a minor injury and presents themselves to the department. We also have some people who present themselves to us with more serious injuries, these patients are signposted to the appropriate place to receive care. There will be the opportunity for you to practice aseptic technique. You will see a lot of x rays and hear a lot of anatomy being talked about. You will be given the opportunity to see the different kind of management of fractures as well as plastering techniques.
