

Bognor Regis War Memorial Hospital – Don Baines Ward

Don Baines Ward is a 24 bedded sub-acute medical and rehabilitation ward catering for mainly the older adult patient and patients with end-of-life care needs. It has a strong multi-disciplinary focus, with nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, social worker, dietician and speech and language therapists working together to provide the best outcome for the patient. This may be returning to own home with/without support or going on for continuing care in a residential/nursing home.

You are expected to work a variety of shifts to gain 24-hour care experience, including weekends. You will be required to always wear your student uniform with ID badge. A 'bare below the elbow' is strictly enforced – so no nail varnish or jewellery apart from a plain wedding band
