Chanctonbury Proactive Care Team provides supportive care within the home environment to prevent inappropriate and unnecessary hospital admissions, supporting the discharge pathway from secondary care and preventing premature admission into long term care. Chanctonbury Proactive Care Team is divided into 3 areas:

- Steyning
- Storrington
- Henfield

### Working Patterns

- Chanctonbury Proactive Care Team covers referrals from 8am-6pm.
- Our core hours are 08.30 -16.30 with a 30 minutes lunch break.
- One member of staff daily is on an early shift starting at 08:00 hours with another on a late shift finishing at 18:00 hours.
- After 18:00 hours Over Night Service then cover referrals until 08:00 hours the following day.

You will be required to always wear your student uniform with ID badge. A 'bare below the elbow' is strictly enforced – so no nail varnish or jewellery apart from a plain wedding band
