

Crawley Hospital – Piper ward

The ward has 10 stroke patient beds and 16 general rehab patient beds. We provide a rehabilitation programme tailored to the needs of the individual patient to enable them to regain maximum function through realistic goal setting. We have an integrated physiotherapy department and an occupational therapy kitchen to assist with patient assessment and rehab. Ward rounds occur twice a week.
