

Crawley Hospital – Viking ward

Viking is a 28 bedded sub-acute medical and rehabilitation ward catering mainly for the older population, although younger patients are sometimes admitted. It is a strong team of nurses, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, social worker, dietician and speech and language therapists working together to provide good quality care and safe discharge to either home or continuing care.

You are expected to work a variety of shifts to gain 24-hour care experience, including weekends. You will be required to always wear your student uniform with ID badge. A 'bare below the elbow' is strictly enforced – so no nail varnish or jewellery apart from a plain wedding band
