G2 work closely as part of the MDT—including Physiotherapists, OT and Social Services. Within this department you may have the opportunity to spend some time with other professionals working in this department such as the End of Life Team, Tissue Viability Nurse Specialist and more... details of this can be found in the Student Handbook that has been created for students and will be given to you on your first day or before if you would like to collect it.
