SRCC is a 12-station satellite haemodialysis unit that run dialysis sessions in 2/3 time slots per day. It is a regional service providing a comprehensive range of renal care for the West Sussex population. We provide the following outpatient clinics; renal consultant clinics, low clearance clinics, IV iron / anaemia clinics, dietician clinic , transplant clinics and PD clinics

Working Patterns

The normal shift times for the nursing staff, are as follows:

Early: 6:30 - 14:30 = 7.5hrs (30min break) Middle: 10:00 - 18:00 = 7.5hrs (30 min break)

Late: 14:30 - 22:30 = 7.5hrs (30min break) Closed on Sundays

You will be required to wear your student uniform with ID badge at all times.

One or two day placement experience may be possible within the following areas: G6, G7, G9, Peritoneal Dialysis Team, Transplant Co-ordinators and access to Team Bed Managers. Note these placements are based at the main WKC at the QA Hospital in Portsmouth.
