Placement details

The Rosemary Foundation is a charitable organisation serving adults within the Petersfield locality living with an end stage terminal prognosis. We offer holistic palliative care in the individual's own home, aiming to maximise quality of life and also as a support mechanism for the family. We collaborate with local hospices, Macmillan teams and GP practices in providing person centred care and our continuous twenty four hour service provides assistance with hygiene and activities of daily living (ADLs), symptom management, emotional and psychological support, as well as post bereavement support to the families.



Learning opportunities and experiences

- -You will learn from the patient and their families the absolute essence of holistic end of life care and you will be exposed to the challenges that dying at home can present.
- -Symptom management using pharmacology and adjuvant interventions
- -How to recognise end of life symptoms and appropriate interventions
- -Enhance knowledge of disease progression and ethics of withdrawal of treatments or introduction of end of life medications
- -Gain understanding of the needs of those involved before, during and post bereavement
- -How to effectively use reflection as a tool to enhance practice and protect your wellbeing
