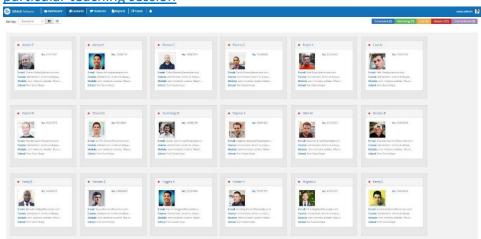


Dear Colleagues,

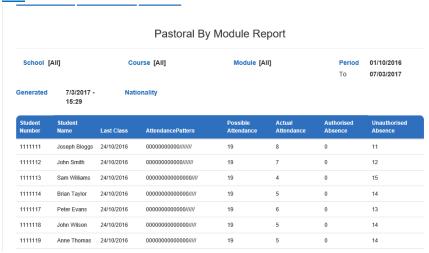

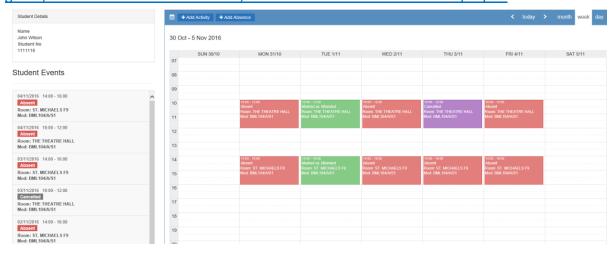
 One possible view for staff wishing to see which students did/didn't attend a particular teaching session



 A summary for staff of student attendance for a whole module, showing number of sessions which each student attended or had an authorised/unauthorised absence for.



• A student view of their timetable and attendance, with attended sessions shown in green, missed sessions shown in red, and cancelled sessions shown in purple.



In our next all staff communication, we will be providing information about when the card readers will be installed in to teaching rooms, and will provide outline details of the staff training programme on the SAM system which is currently expected to commence in mid-June.

The second email communication to students who will be continuing their studies with us in September 2017 will be sent in the next few weeks and regular communications to students will continue to be provided throughout the remaining duration of the SAM Project.
